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

Chord Shapes:



- Strum down on the & of first measure of the A chord
- After that you will strum up on the & after the 1st beat
- Switching from strumming down on the off beat of 4 to the offbeat of the 1st beat is something that will take some time, take it slow and count it ou loud but if you get that down the intro will sound amazing.

Verse Strum Pattern

- The real harmony is based around an E major chord
- The band is playing an E5 chord, or an E power chord
- You can play any of the three shapes that you like, you can also mix them if you like certain shapes for certain parts of the song.

Pre-Chorus Strum Pattern

- Here is the basic outline for the strum but I encourage doing something else to build up the energy.
