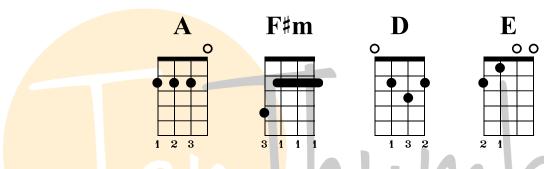

Chord Progression

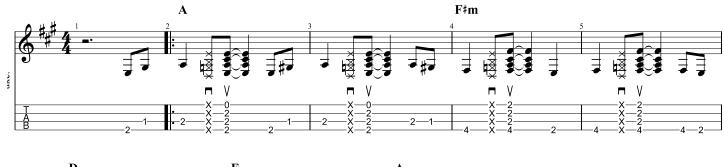

Tips for bass groove

- The bass grove is straight forward, they are all $8^{\rm th}$ notes on the $4^{\rm th}$ beat apart from the first F#m measure where you play a $\frac{1}{4}$ note.
- Note how all the notes end a note in the chord, these are called "chord tones" and as you continue to learn more about bass you will see that bass lines revolve around chord tones and arpeggios.
- The bass functions as a bridge between the drums and the harmony, meaning guitar, piano, ukulele, etc.
- That is why some people joke about not noticing the bass, but that is okay because the purpose of the bass isn't the flash, ornamentation, or accent, it is there to bring things together.
- If you understand intervals try and transpose this bass line, exercises like that will open the entire fretboard to you.
